Waiver: Each team must complete their waiver/ roster form and submit to the tournament director before first game.

Any teams not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to play in the tournament.

GAME RULES:

All Iowa High School Boys/Girls Association rules for basketball apply with the following exceptions:

a. 16 minute halves with continuous clock. (Clock will stop the last minute of the **2nd half only** if score difference is 12 points or less. Clock will stop for all time-outs and injuries.)

- b. Three minutes between halves.
- c. 3 time-outs per game. 30 seconds allowed for each time-out.
- d. Overtime period 1 minute in length, clock stops for each dead ball. One 30-second timeout will be awarded to each team. No carry over time-outs allowed from regulation or other overtime periods. A second overtime will be sudden death where the first score wins.
- e. Each technical or intentional foul will result in 2 points and possession of the ball awarded to the opposing team. A second technical foul by a coach or player will result in removal from the tournament.
- f. Shoot one-and-one free throws on the 7th foul in each half and two on the 10th foul.
- g. 3-point shots are allowed on all courts.
- h. 3rd & 4th grade will use a shortened free throw line.
- i. Backcourt defense (press) in the 3rd, 4th and 5th grade games is only allowed in the final 2 minutes of each half and overtime. No backcourt defense is allowed in any division by a team that is leading by 15 or more points.
- j. **No zone defense or half court trapping** is allowed in the 3rd, 4th and 5th grade divisions. Zone presses are allowed but must fall back to man defense.
- k. All divisions will use a 28.5" basketball. **Both teams must provide a game ball. Referees will make final decision on game ball to be used.** 8th grade boys division has the option to use a 29.5" ball if both coaches agree.
- 1. No more than 2 coaches on the bench per game. Only the head coach may stand to coach.
- m. Coaches will be responsible for the conduct of their players and parents. Please stress **sportsmanship** at all times with our game officials, tournament volunteers, other players, coaches, and fans attending the games. Game or tournament officials may eject any coach, player, or spectator from the tournament. Any person ejected will be required to leave the premises immediately and will not be allowed back into any tournament game.

TEAM RULES:

- a. Each team must be prepared to provide an adult scorekeeper and/or clock keeper for each game.
- b. Team rosters established before the team's first game is the roster that must be used for the entire tournament.
- c. A lower grade player may compete on a team in a higher grade bracket.
- d. An individual player may play on only one team in this tournament.
- e. Teams must have light and dark uniforms or reversible jerseys with numbers on both sides.
- f. The team listed last or on the bottom of the bracket will be the home team and will wear the light uniform.

FACILITY RULES:

- a. No food or drinks are to be brought into the schools from outside. A full concession stand will be available onsite.
- b. Players must be supervised at all times by parents or coach.
- c. Entrance to the North Scott Junior High School gyms will be through the southwest door entrance only.
- d. Admission is Prepaid. No money will be taken at the door.
- e. The North Scott School district, volunteers, and/or tournament committee members shall not be held responsible for accidents, injuries, or the theft of personal property incurred by anyone participating, attending, or working in the North Scott Run and Gun Shootout.
- f. All injuries are the responsibility of the individual teams, coaches and parents of the player involved. No medical personnel are located on-site. Ice and a First-aid kit will be available at the concession stand.
- g. No tobacco products are allowed on school property.
